The Service:	A comprehensive referral service tailored to each employee's child care needs (Elder Care services are also available and are similar to the child care service.) The Service: • e-Child Care Searches for your employees (additional cost may apply). Call for more information.			
	 The employee calls the Council's corporate extension and speaks directly to a Child Care Specialist who will support them throughout their child care search. The Child Care Specialist provides an overview of the child care options, indicators of quality care, and the process of searching for care. The Child Care Specialist researches child care programs that meet the employee's needs and calls each to identify those with an opening. A packet of information is mailed to the employee. The packet includes, but is not limited to, detailed profiles of the referrals with openings for their child, a handbook on choosing child care, and additional educational materials that will assist them with their search. Ongoing check-in calls by the Child Care Specialist with the employee throughout their search and to provide additional information if necessary. Quality Assurance calls to evaluate the service and ask for suggestions on how it might be improved. 			
Educational Information:	 Free publications for employees requesting child and/or elder care. Quarterly electronic newsletter for working parents. 			
Contract Management:	The Director of Employer and Parent Services partners with your company's representative to promote the service. The Director is also available as a resource for other work/life issues.			
Reports:	Reports are provided with detailed information on employee usage, overview of the services provided, and quality assurance data. Reports can be customized based on company requirements.			
Work/Life Seminars:	Each on-site seminar is tailored to meet the needs of your employees.
